
Gov. Tony Evers has declared a Public Health Emergency, and issued an Emergency Order, requiring individuals to wear face coverings when indoors and not in a private residence, with some exceptions.








When at your



When indoors or in an enclosed space that is not your private residence.

private residence.





You are indoors and there is not another person in the room or space.

Ex: Two coworkers share the same office building, but they each have complete separate offices. Masks are not required.

Children under the age of 5. Children under the age of 2 should NOT wear a face covering.

When outdoors.



It is highly recommended to wear a face covering when you are outdoors and physical distancing (6 ft) can't be maintained. Children between the ages of 2-5 are encouraged to wear a face covering when physical distancing can't be maintained.
