

Town of Loyal 2021 WisDOT LRIP TRIP Project

Town of Loyal, Clark County, is requesting sealed bids from qualified contractors for the following Local Road Improvement Project (LRIP). This is a Town Road Improvement (TRIP) Project.

Project is bid as lump sum bid awarded to one bidder for complete project including all materials, labor, equipment and incidentals to satisfactory complete the project:

- Resurface one half miles of 26th Road; from Hwy K west to Miller Avenue.
- Aggregate material shall be compacted following specification 305.3.2 Compaction.
- Supply, apply, compact and grade approximately 2,200 tons of 3/4" CRUSHED STONE BASE AGGREGATE DENSE. 28 feet wide by 6 inches thick compacted.
 - Aggregate shall meet all Wisconsin Department of Transportation applicable standards and specifications.
 - Aggregate shall come from a Wisconsin Department of Transportation certified pit that has been tested for wear and soundness.
 - Aggregate must be uniform in quality and free from wood, soil and other deleterious materials.
 - Vendor shall provide sieve analysis of material which sample has been obtained from source stockpile following specification 860.
 - Material must be at an acceptable moisture content meeting 860.4; maximum 7%. No water shall be added after final production process. Material must be loaded from stockpile which has had enough time to allow sufficient amount of process water to drain out of material to prevent saturation. Moisture needed for compaction shall be added after the material is weighed and placed on the road.
 - Digital printed tickets from a certified scale are required for each load, meeting specification 109 Measurement and Payment.
 - Aggregate shall be in accordance with the requirements of the "State of Wisconsin Standard Specifications for Highway and Structure Construction", Section 301 and 305. The supplier will be responsible for performing all testing.
- Project shall be completed by September 15, 2021; \$100 per day penalty if not completed on time.
- Town will obtain all necessary permits.
- All Bids shall be submitted on a completed and signed Town supplied Bid Form Document.
